

Fluke Calibration Trade-Up / Trade-In Program

Terms and conditions

Description of the program

Trade in a calibrator, reference source, standard, shunt, dc reference, or metrology digital multimeter and receive a 10% discount of the purchase of a new instrument.

Additionally, if an eligible calibrator or metrology DMM is purchased before June 30, 2009, Customer will receive a license for MET/CAL® Calibration Management Software at no cost.

The Fluke Calibration Trade-Up / Trade-In Program is available to Customers in the United States and Canada.

To participate in the program, Customer must follow this process:

- 1) Customer purchases one of the eligible instruments, specified on the table below.
- 2) Fluke sends a sales order to Customer confirming receipt of the order and planned date of shipment.
- 3) Customer receives the new instrument.
- 4) Within 45 days of receiving the new instrument, Customer sends the instrument to be traded in, as well as a copy of the sales order, to this address:

- 5) If Customer has purchased an eligible instrument, a license CD for MET/CAL® software will be shipped directly to Customer from Fluke after the trade-in unit is received. To be eligible, the purchase order for the instrument must be received at Fluke by close of business on June 30, 2009. Customer must complete IRS Form W9 and include it with the purchase order. Form W-9 is the IRS form used to request your taxpayer identification number. Customers may download a Form-W9 from the internet or request a blank form from their local Fluke sales representative.
- 6) If Fluke does not receive the trade-in unit within 45 days, Fluke will invoice Customer for the balance of the original list price of the purchased instrument.
